## INDEPENDENT ASSURANCE REPORT

## Respective responsibilities of the Executive Committee and ourselves

The Executive Committee Members are responsible for preparing the attached income and expenditure account in accordance with the basis of preparation set out in note 2, setting out the gross subscriptions raised from the Event and the expenses incurred in connection with the Event, in order to comply with the conditions stated in the Public Subscription Permit issued by the Social Welfare Department of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region ("SWD"). This responsibility includes designing, implementing and maintaining internal controls relevant to the preparation and presentation of the income and expenditure account so that it reflects the subscriptions raised and expenses incurred in connection with the Event and is free from material misstatement.

It is our responsibility to form a conclusion on the attached income and expenditure account, based on our engagement, and to report our conclusion to you.

#### Basis of conclusion

We conducted our engagement in accordance with Hong Kong Standard on Assurance Engagements 3000 "Assurance Engagements Other Than Audits or Reviews of Historical Financial Information" and with reference to the "Circular on Reporting on General Charitable Fund-raising Activities Covered by Public Subscription Permits issued by the Social Welfare Department (Other than Flag Days)" issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants ("HKICPA").

The work undertaken in connection with this engagement is less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Hong Kong Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

Furthermore, due to the nature of cash receipts and expenses relating to general charitable fund-raising activities, it was not practicable for us to determine whether the income and expenditure account and the books and records of the Society include all transactions relating to the Event. It was impracticable for us to quantify the potential impact of this on the income and expenditure account. Accordingly, our report relates solely to the income and expenditure account prepared from transactions that have been recorded in the Society's books and records.

Our engagement included carrying out limited procedures for obtaining sufficient appropriate evidence to be able to draw a conclusion, such as inquiries primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters and other procedures we considered necessary.

## THE LOTTERY EVENT "HEEP HONG SOCIETY GRAND RAFFLE 2012" NOTES TO THE INCOME AND EXPENDITURE ACCOUNT

#### FOR THE PERIOD FROM 27 MARCH, 2012 TO 21 MAY, 2012

#### 1. General

In accordance with Section 22(1)(a)(i) of the Gambling Ordinance (Cap.148), Heep Hong Society has obtained a Lottery Licence No. 4251 on 6 March, 2012 from The Commissioner for Television and Entertainment Licensing in respect of Heep Hong Society's sale of raffle tickets held during the period from 27 March, 2012 to 21 May, 2012. The draw of the lottery event was held on 21 May, 2012.

#### 2. Basis of preparation

The income and expenditure account has been prepared on the cash receipts and disbursements basis. On this basis, income is recognised when received and expenditures are recognised when paid.

#### 3. Surplus

The total surplus of HK\$1,344,202 will form part of revenue of Heep Hong Society. The executive committee have determined to use the surplus in support of its services for children with special needs and their families.
